Public Access Policy

The committee wishes Morwenstow Community Centre to be accessible to all members of our community, and the wider area.

We are aware that some disabled people, as well as people with prams and push-chairs, young children and some older people, have particular difficulties in dealing with an environment designed without their needs in mind.

Internally, all areas are on one level and doorways are wide enough, including double doors, to allow easy access for wheelchairs etc.

The main entrance is a double door which allows for wheelchair access with a little assistance and is ambulant disabled friendly.

There is a toilet with wheelchair access.

In line with the Parish Council policy regarding the Playing Field, no dogs (with the exception of assistance dogs) are allowed on the site.

When the venue is let, the hirer is responsible for ensuring care of children and vulnerable adults under the provision of the current legislation.

As we improve and refurbish the Community Centre, we will give careful consideration to our building and facilities, bearing in mind the terms of the Disability Discrimination Act.
